He told the ladies that ZimRelief has come to Zimbabwe specifically to assist selected independent local initiatives dealing with education to enable participating students to discover and develop skills that will lead them to lead free and independent lives. Glen Forest was one of the selected project.

Support started in 2007 to date. Groceries for the feeding scheme were bought for the Orphans and Vulnerable children of the poor farm communities of Glen Forest. Scholarships for O' level and A' level students have consecutively been offered to the needy and in some cases bus fare. Examinations fees have been paid and students who benefitted have proceeded to either advanced level or they have found something to do for a living have attended certain skills training courses
